#### **EMBLEM**

On a shield per fess nebuly abaisse, azure and argent; in chief a Roman Helmet proper with black detail, crested gules, surmounting a lightning bolt or and a refueling boom proper in saltire, all between two stars or; in base a laurel branch vert and a quill pen proper, above a star or; the shield edged of the last. **SIGNIFICANCE:** The emblem symbolizes the qualities of esprit de corps and the many phases of the mission. The field of the shield is blue and white representing the sky, the air theater of operations. The Roman helmet is for defense protection; the lightning bolt is for swiftness; the refueling boom symbolizes the vital mission; air refueling; the golden stars in the blue sky stand for the two tactical squadrons; the heraldric nebuly partitian of the field indicates SAC is a skylike fortress; laurel indicates peace; the quill pen relates to the broad administrative responsibility; the golden star marking the cloud-like fortress is for the group. The colors symbolize the noble attributes; white--honor; blue--air surpremecy and red--valor and bloodshed. (Approved, 20 Aug 1956)

#### **OPERATIONS**

From 1955 to 1963, conducted aerial refueling of Strategic Air Command manned bombers and other US military aircraft as directed.

4050 AREFW was called upon to fill in on refueling missions to support tactical air command when air force KC-50 fleet was grounded. 1962

1962-4050 AREFW steps were taken by 4050 air refueling wing at Westover AFB MA to suspend all normal flying activities (and alert posture was increased to meet higher headquarters mission requirements) during Cuban missile crisis of late Oct 62. Wing increased its KC-135 airborne alert support, and all wing personnel went on seven day week schedule with all sections being manned 24 hours per day.
