Maintenance Personnel Began Testing A New Concept In Aircraft Maintenance On 8 May 62; Called Project High Blower the concept was designed to increase sortic production, improve maintenance quality, decrease aircraft downtime, and reduce personnel authorization.

1962 Alert Force Of 4123 Strategic Wing (Consisted Of Eight B-52 And Seven Kc-135 Aircraft That Were Fully Manned And Combat Ready

Activated At Carswell AFB, Texas, On 10/12/57. Moved To Clinton-Sherman AFB, OK, On 25/2/59. Inactivated 1/2/63 when aircraft and personnel assets passed to 70 Bw At the same base.
