After Williams AFB, Arizona, was transferred from the Air Training Command to the Tactical Air Command in 1958, the 3525th CCTW was redesignated as the 4530th CCTW. This unit flew Super Sabres from July 1958 until October 1960.

1960 Williams AFB, Arizona. On 1 October Tactical Air Command transferred Williams AFB to ATC. This Arizona base would become part of ATC's new consolidated pilot training program. On the same date, Tactical Air Command reassigned its 4530th Combat Crew Training Wing (Tactical Fighter) and subordinate units at Williams to Air Training Command, and ATC discontinued the wing. Concurrently, Air Training Command used assets from the 4530th to organize and establish the 3525th Pilot Training Wing.
