Detachment One of the First Fighter Interceptor Wing at George AFB, Victorville, California, under the Command of Lt Col Wilson V. Edwards, was sent to Yuma. There, it was inactivated and replaced by the 4750 Air Base Squadron. This unit had the responsibility of establishing a Weapons Training Center for fighter-interceptor units of the Western Air Defense Forces, a part of the newly formed Air Defense Command.

On 1 March 1952, the 4705th Defense Wing was discontinued and its units, the 94th and 188th Fighter-Interceptor Squadrons, were assigned directly to the 27th Air Division (Defense), and the

4750th Air Base Squadron (Gunnery Training) was assigned to Headquarters Western Air Defense Force.
