OPERATIONS

With construction of new AFSWC headquarters buildings completed in 1955, along with new hangars capable of handling the Boeing B-52 bombers and other large aircraft flown and used by the Center's units, the 4900th Air Base Group replaced the 4910th Air Base Group as the base housekeeping unit and served in that capacity for the next 22 years. Construction of the base's permanent administrative and service facilities was essentially completed by 1960, when the chapel and final Capehart housing units were accepted.

Kirtland Air Force Base, Sandia Base, and Manzano Base merged with Air Force Logistics Command assuming maintenance and storage responsibility with the 3098th Aviation Depot Squadron replacing the 1094th Aviation Depot Group at the Manzano Weapons Storage Area; and Air Force Systems Command taking over support and security responsibility for Kirtland Air Force Base with the 4900th Air Base Group. 1 Jul 1971

4900th Air Base Group redesignated the 4900th Air Base Wing and placed under the Air Force Contract Management Division. 1 Apr 1976
