Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 15 October 1921 as 6th Wing Headquarters (Attack), assigned to the Fourth Army, and allotted to the Third Corps Area. Headquarters initiated on 1 March 1922 at Franklin, PA. Redesignated as Headquarters, 6th Attack Wing on 8 May 1929. Inactivated on 3 December 1926 at Franklin by relief of personnel. Redesignated as Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron, 6th Attack Wing on 1 September 1936.
