The 9th Maintenance Operations Squadron provides world-class staffing, training and equipping of aviation maintenance personnel, additionally the 9th MOS provides world-class resource planning, scheduling, management and analysis to ensure a ready, viable Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance fleet in support of the 9th Reconnaissance Wing's peacetime and wartime efforts.

Nearly 80 active duty and civilian members are assigned to the 9th MOS. The unit is organized into three flights.
