OPERATIONS

USAFSS activated most new units at its headquarters in Texas before relocating those organizations to their new bases. On 1 July 1953, the command activated the 6901st Special Communications Center at Brooks AFB "to perform the operational functions previously handled by the Analysis and Disseminations Divisions, Deputy Chief of Staff/Operations, HQ USAFSS." The 6901st SCC concentrated on intercepted communications collected by the command's European-based units. Later in 1953, USAFSS stood up the 6902nd SCC on Security Hill at Kelly AFB to perform a similar function for intercepted data from its units in the Far East.

Then on 8 August, the command relocated the 6901st Special Communications Center to Kelly and renamed it the Air Force Special Communications Center.
