HQ USAFSS activated the 6926 Radio Squadron, Mobile at Kelly AFB in late 1955 to monitor tracking of the recon balloons. Drawing upon resources from subordinate organizations, USAFSS deployed the 6926 and a series of detachments to forward locations in Alaska and the Far East in support of the project.

On 1 September 1963, the 6925 Security Group acquired a newly activated, truly mobile unit— 6926 Security Squadron (Mobile) at Clark Air Base.

the 6926 SS (M) provided Pacific Security Region with a capability to deploy on short notice to meet national and theater intelligence needs in areas where adequate fixed facilities did not exist.
