81st Air Base Group constituted 1 Aug 1941 and activated about 11 Aug 1941 at Kelly Fld, TX. Moved to Lake Charles AAF, LA, Nov 1941, where it was redesignated 81st Service Group on 13 Jun 1942. Activated Air Service Command Training Center, Fresno, CA. 81 Air Base Group, HQ & HQ Sq redesignated 81 Service Group, HQ & HQ Sq (AG 320.2, 10 Jun 42). Original mission supply and maintain very heavy bombardment groups equipped with B-29 aircraft. Conducted Movement to Stinson Field, San Antonio, TX, thence to Robins Field, GA. Redesignated 81 Air Service Group. Reorganization to support fighter groups. Conducted overseas movement to North Airfield, Iwo Jima Island, Volcano Islands. Disbanded 8 Oct 48.
