Organized October 26th, 1918, as an Overseas Organization. The following officers were assigned on
October 31st, 1918:

R. S. Walton, 2nd Lieut. A.S. (Aero), from Commanding Officer 48th Balloon Company to Commanding Officer 81st Balloon Company.

Bernard M. Murphy, 2nd Lieut. A.S. (Aero), from 61st Balloon Company to Company Adjutant 81st Balloon Company.

Edwin S. Kassler, Jr., 2nd Lieut. A.S. (Aero), from 74th Balloon Company to Supply Officer 81st Balloon Company.

On November 12th, 1918, 60 enlisted men and on November 13th, 1918, 20 enlisted men from the different companies in the Fort and Florence Field were assigned to this company. On December 1st, 1918, 15 unassigned men from Fort Crook were attached, making the total strength of this company 106 men.
