Constituted as the 8164th Replacement Training Squadron, the unit was assigned to the 164th

Fighter-Bomber Squadron for administrative and logistical support. The 8164th received federal recognition effective 16 May 1955, at the Municipal Airport, Mansfield, Ohio. Formal acceptance of the unit was effected by the Adjutant General in General Order 16, on 19 April 1955.

The 8164 Replacement Training Squadron was discontinued 31 May 1957. All personnel from the Replacement Training Squadron were assigned to the 164th Fighter Interceptor Squadron effective 1 June 1957.
