OPERATIONS

During the first half of 1953 some of the squadron members were released from active duty and returned to the Connecticut Air National Guard. These men were placed in the 8240th Air Base Squadron, a temporary holding unit awaiting the return of the 103rd Aircraft Control Warning Squadron to State control. Much of the planning and ground work was completed during this period so as to enable the unit to accomplish the resumption of operations as a Guard unit with little delay. Great changes were accomplished. Milford was designated as the Squadron's Headquarters and the Groton station was a detachment.
