#### **OPERATIONS**

Organized provisionally at Manhattan, NY, in March 1922 as General Headquarters Air Service in accordance with Second Corps Area General Orders. Formally constituted in the Organized Reserve on 31 March 1924 as Headquarters, General Headquarters Air Service, allotted to the Second Corps Area, and initiated with personnel from the existing unit in Manhattan.

Inactivated in 1925 at Manhattan by relief of personnel. Relieved from the Second Corps Area in 1925 and allotted to the First Corps Area. Boston, MA, designated by November 1925 as headquarters on reorganization, but the unit was never organized at that location. This unit functioned as a reserve pool for the assignment of officers only. It did not function as an actual headquarters. Redesignated Headquarters, General Headquarters Aviation 3 March 1928. Discontinued in 1929.
