The USAF Hospital System was approved for implementation this date. Six area Medical Centers and 14 Regional Hospitals were designated in CONUS. Fixed hospitals and dispensaries in AFLC (with the exception of USAF Hospital Wright-Patterson) were redesignated USAF hospitals and dispensaries with the base name. The 2791 USAF Hospital at Hill AFB became USAF Hospital Hill. 1 JUL 1969

The reassignment of Lt. Colonel John E. Touhey, Commander USAF Hospital Hill brought Colonel Donald E. Rice here as his successor. 27 jul 1976

Succeeding Colonel Donald E. Rice, Commander USAF Hospital Hill upon his reassignment to Castle Air Force Base was Colonel Romulus S. von Hazmburg. 8 aug 1978
