Starting with a single unit, the 197th FS which was federally recognized in December 1946, the Arizona ANG has grown into a four-squadron force. The second of these squadrons, the 152nd FIS, was activated in May 1956 and served between September 1969 and July 1979 as a replacement training unit. Two specialized RTUs were organized in February 1984 (195th TFTS) and October 1985 (148th TFTS).

At the end of FY92, 3,032 officers and enlisted personnel manned 28 AZ ANG units, including the 197th ARS flying KC-135Es from the Sky Harbor IAP in Phoenix and the 148th, 152nd and 195th FSs flying F-16A/Bs from Tucson. Since January 1990, the 148th TFTS has been training F-16 pilots not only for other ANG squadrons but also for the Royal Netherlands Air Force.
