## **OPERATIONS**

The State Headquarters, Minnesota Air National Guard, was activated and granted Federal recognition on 1 November 1951. Prior to that date, Air Staff Officers were assigned positions in the Army State Headquarters. The staff initially was held to a minimum number of officers and was not fully manned until 1966 when Brigadier General Alfred C. Schwab, Jr., became the Chief of Staff. From 1951 to 1966 Colonel Leo Goodrich was the Chief of Staff except for a three month interval in 1960 when the staff was commanded by Colonel Ralph M. Jerome. Since 1966 the staff has been fully manned and has been given the responsibility for assisting The Adjutant General in the management of both Air National Guard bases in the state of Minnesota.
