The mission of the is to acquire, manage, and dispose of all Air Force—controlled real property worldwide. In addition to BRAC and active duty real property transactions, agency responsibilities include executing Enhanced-Use Leases (EULs) and management of environmental restoration programs at Legacy BRAC bases. Air Force Real Property Agency has 198 civilian personnel and contractors, including specialists in real property, environmental cleanup and compliance, financial management, facility operations and maintenance, public affairs, environmental and real estate law, civilian personnel, and information systems.

Air Force Real Property Agency completed its own BRAC relocation from Rosslyn, VA., to San Antonio, TX. Air Force Real Property Agency is fully operational and will be collocated with the Air Force Center for Engineering and the Environment, enhancing the agency's ability to efficiently and effectively execute its mission.
