### **OPERATIONS**

Effective 1 January 1977, ATC activated the San Antonio Procurement Center at Kelly AFB. The center was responsible for all base procurement functions at Kelly, Brooks, Lackland, and Randolph. It was to be a group-level organization under the operational control of the ATC Deputy Chief of Staff, Logistics.

In January 1978, ATC noted that the San Antonio Procurement Center had encountered major problems due to its location at Kelly AFB, an Air Force Logistics Command installation. Since the San Antonio Real Property Maintenance Agency was its major customer, ATC decided to collocate both organizations at the San Antonio Air Force Station. The move began at the end of 1978 and ended in May 1979.

Also on 1 October 1978, Air Training Command redesignated the procurement center as the San Antonio Contracting Center.

Effective 1 April 1989, ATC inactivated its San Antonio Contracting Center (SACC).
