EMBLEM

On a disc Sable, a globe rising from dexter base Azure, gridlined of the field, emitting a contrail from sinister to dexter chief Gules, terminating in a stylized flight symbol Silver Gray, overall a lightning bolt bendwise Or; all within a narrow Gold border. Attached above the disc, a Black scroll edged with a narrow Gold border and inscribed "DISCOVERING THE TRUTH" in Gold letters. Attached below the disc, a Black scroll edged with a narrow Gold border and inscribed "SIGNALS ANALYSIS SQUADRON" in Gold letters. Approved on 10 Feb 2010.

EMBLEM SIGNIFICANCE

Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The globe ties to the globe on the NASIC emblem and represents the Center's role in the Air Force vision of Global Vigilance, Reach and Power. The aerospace craft and contrail symbolizes the air and space systems that are the Squadron's analytical responsibility. The stylized 20th Century lightning bolt symbolizes the roots of the Squadron's mission being coincident with the roots of radio communications. The unit motto is "Discovering the Truth."
