

## 366 LOGISTICS READINESS SQUADRON



### MISSION

The 366 LRS provides worldwide logistics support for the wing's F-15E aircraft and Expeditionary Combat Support Units. Administers a \$15 million stock fund, \$1.7 million budget, three supply accounts valued at more than \$800 million and a 4.5 million gallon fuels storage area. The squadron operates and maintains an almost 700-vehicle fleet worth about \$47 million. Executes deployments for more than 4,000 passengers/50 C-17-equivalent loads of cargo. The travel management office directs personal property shipments for a two-state area.
